PARKING Parking in the Figge lot and on the street is FREE! There are also 2 parking ramps available adjacent to the museum at Harrison and 2nd Street or River Drive and Main Street.

TIMING The museum opens at Noon on Sundays. Allow yourself enough time to arrive at the museum and make it to the 2nd floor gallery and auditorium in time for your school's ceremony. Check the ceremony time with your art teacher, they are held in groups by school. Each ceremony lasts about 25–30 minutes.

PHOTOGRAPHY This is a GREAT time for a photo opp! Non-flash photography is welcome in the museum except where posted (near certain artworks). Don't forget to tag the Figge Art Museum on Facebook!
