MUSEUM HIGHLIGHTS

Inside the Figge you will discover two important museum collections that span 500 years. This tour highlights several works in both the Figge Art Museum and University of Iowa Museum of Art collections.

Optional Art Activity

Create a simple hand-made journal that you can use for sketching or journaling.

PORTRAITS

Centuries-old portraits encourage us to imagine what life was like in different time periods, places, and cultures. This tour highlights memorable portraits by American, British, Dutch and Scottish artists, plus two self-portraits by Midwest Regionalist Grant Wood.

Optional Art Activity

Try a self-portrait after you learn about proportions used for drawing faces.





LANDSCAPES

A landscape is more than just a beautiful painting of nature. This tour will explore realistic and expressive landscapes in our American, Midwest Regionalist and European collections. Our *River of Life* window by Louis Comfort Tiffany is also highlighted in this tour.

Optional Art Activity

Create your own colorful pastel inspired by a favorite landscape in the Figge collection.

SCULPTURE

Whether a work of art is cast in bronze or assembled from scrap metal, sculpture has a wonderful tactile quality that is appealing to the eye. This tour will introduce you to both representational and abstract works in a variety of mediums.

Optional Art Activity Create a mixed media sculpture using a variety

SACRED IMAGES IN ART

For centuries, artists have used symbols to communicate biblical stories. This tour will help you recognize religious figures depicted in our European and Mexican Colonial collections based on attributes and symbolic colors.
